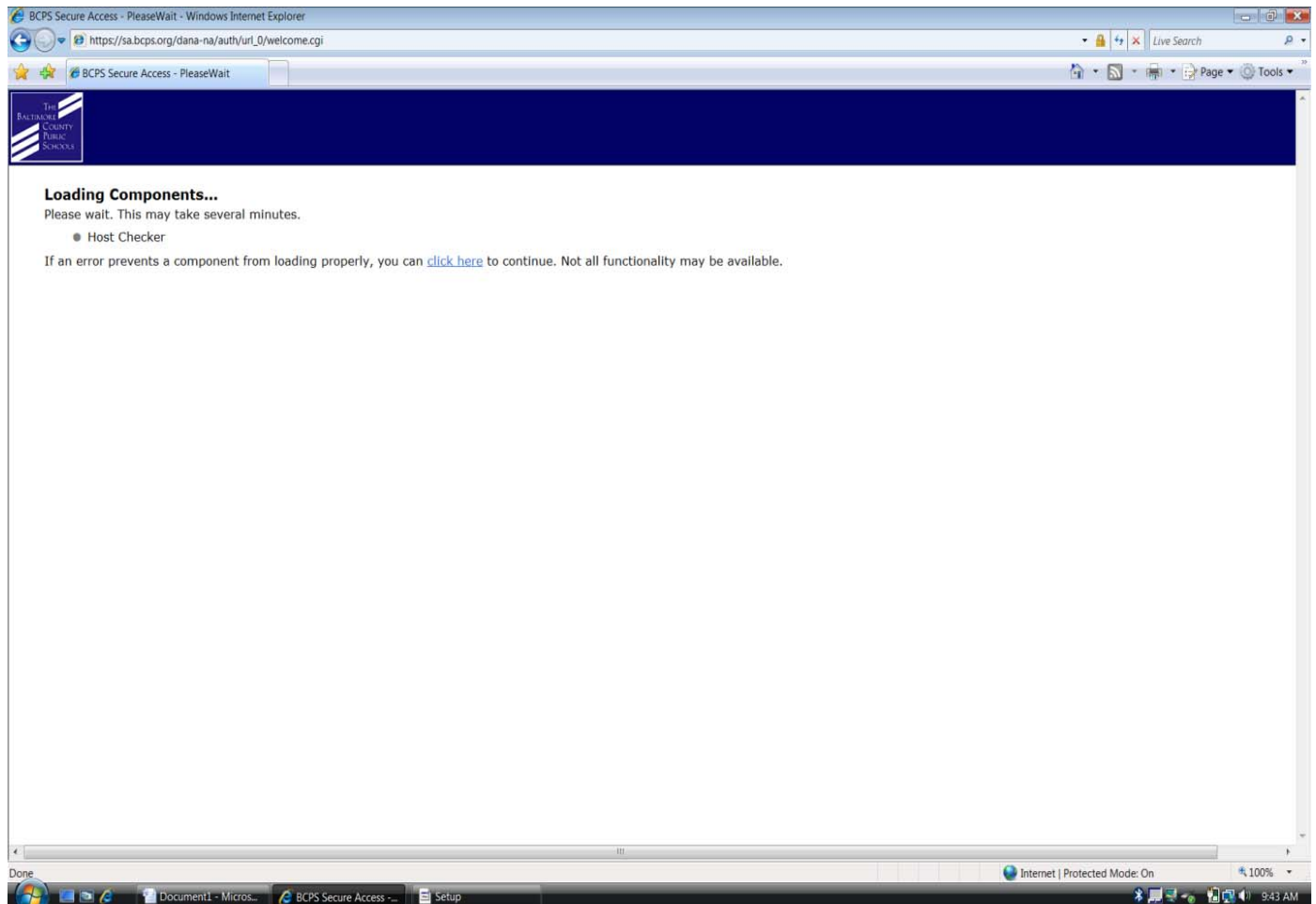


## Juniper – VPN/SSL ACCESS (WINDOWS VISTA)

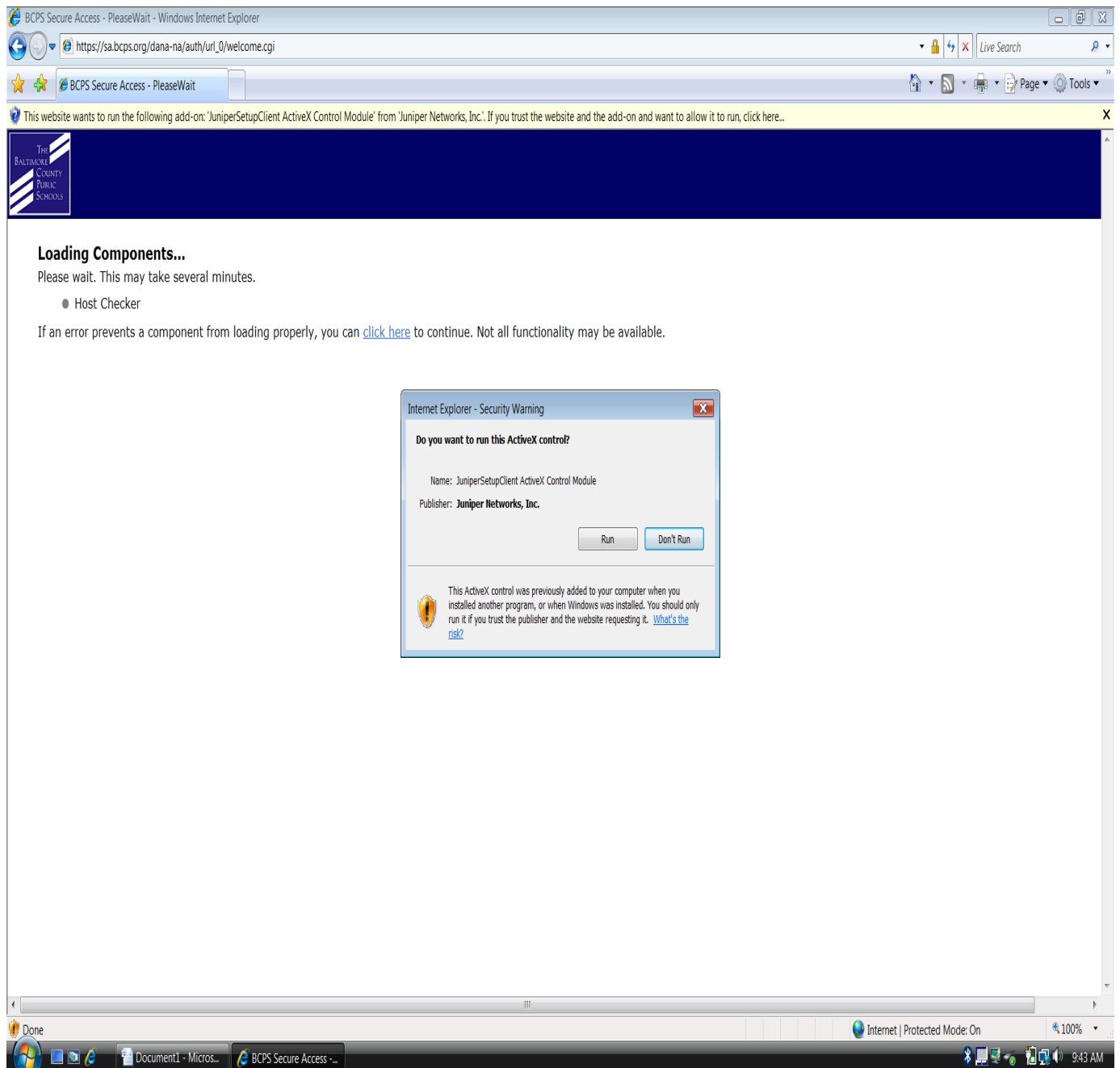
**Vista Users** Open Internet Explorer and type in the URL <http://sa.bcps.org/vista>.

Host checker launches and loads components to evaluate the system and ensure that the PC conforms to standard industry specifications. You need to ensure your system is safe by updating the Antivirus software periodically as required.

You will see the screen below:



Within a few seconds, you will see a message popup below the URL in the browser as shown below



(If Host Checker is being installed for the first time, the system attempts to install using either an ActiveX or a Java delivery method)

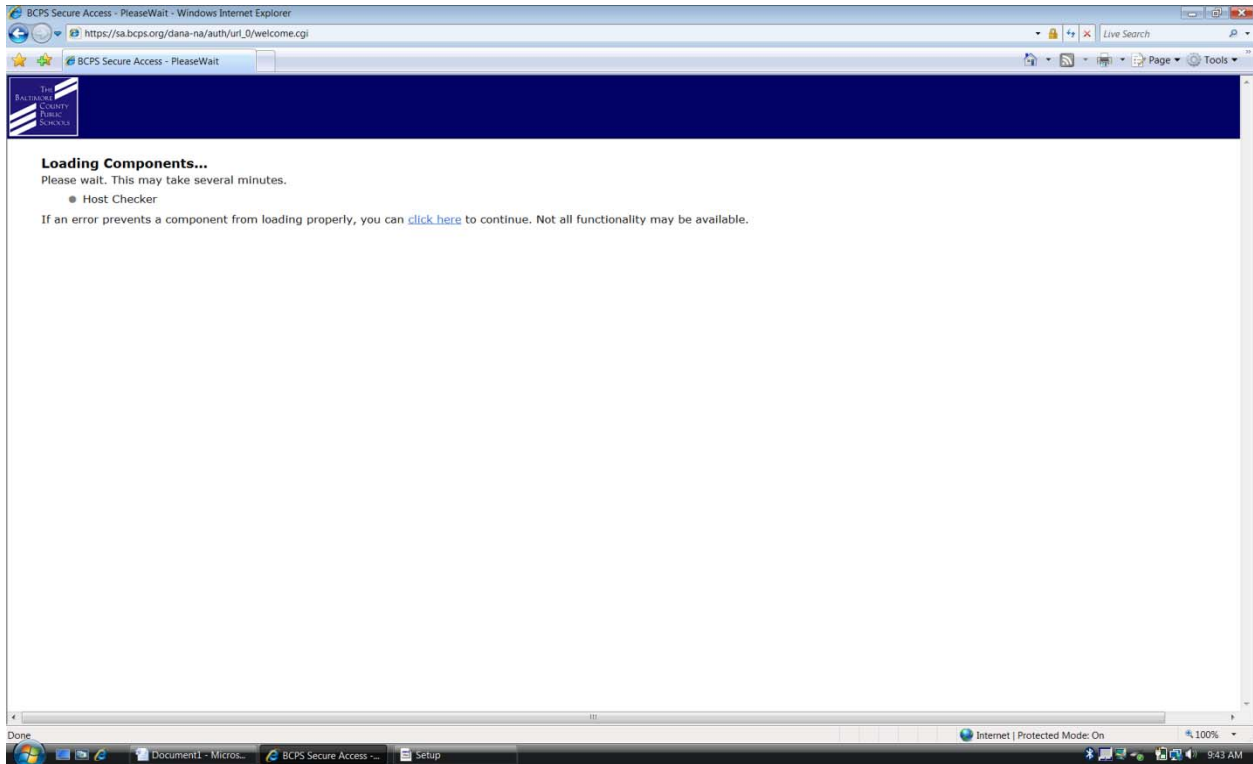
Click on the message that pops up below the URL in the browser allowing the JuniperSetupClient ActiveX Control Module to run, it pops up the dialog box as **above** in case of an ActiveX Control , and in case of Java delivery method it throws a similar dialog box with the question

Do you want to run this software?

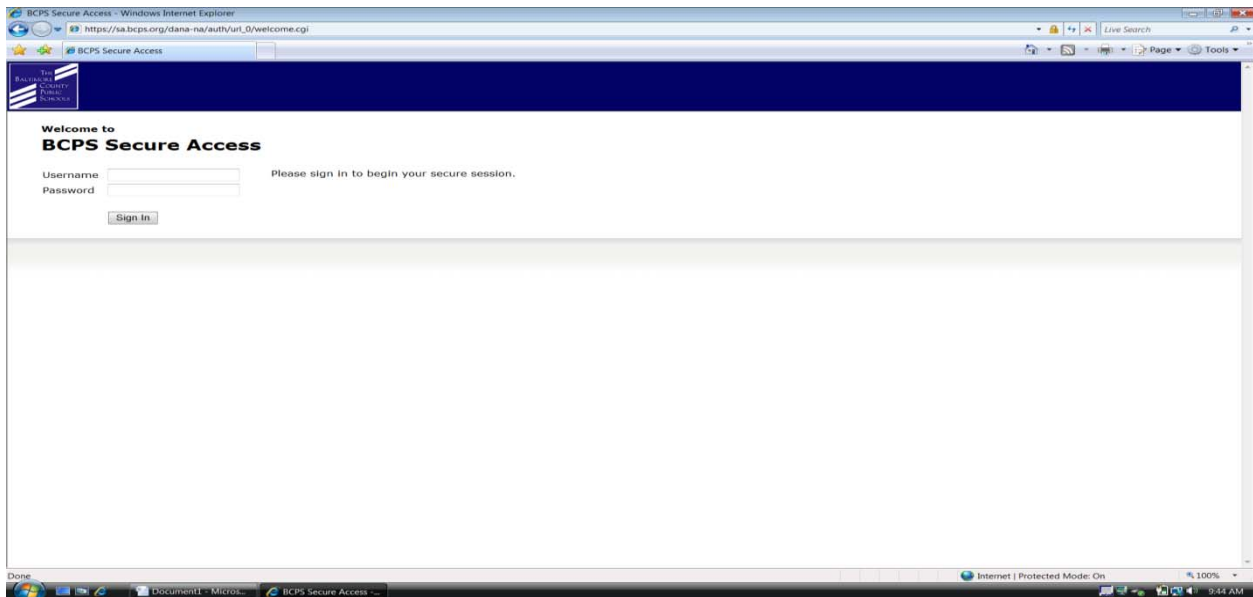
Name: JuniperSetupClientInstaller.exe.

In either case click on Run.

While setup is running the screen below is displayed



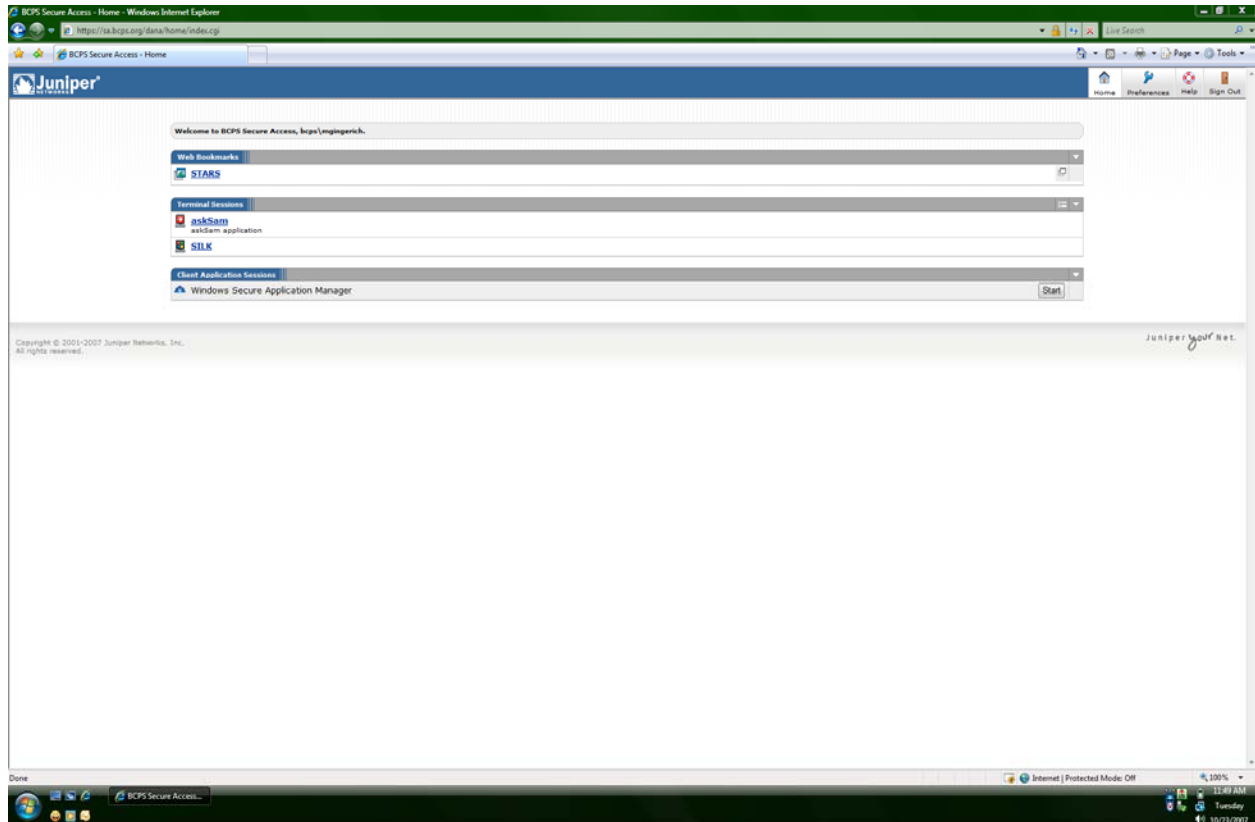
Within a few seconds the following screen will be displayed



Please enter your BCPS username and password and then click on Sign In.

For security reasons never allow Internet Explorer to remember user names and/or passwords. Always select No if a window appears asking to remember credentials

The screen below is displayed once your password is accepted:



Please click on the links related to your applications and enter your login name and password to access

Once you finish working on the application, please sign out of the application as you would normally do, and then click on the sign out found in the top right had corner of the screen above. For stronger security also close Internet Explorer when you are done.
